

LATEST DECISIONS

1. The Library of Congress, Washington, DC and Local 2910, AFS-ME, AFL-CIO, Case No. 07 FSIP 111 (January 15, 2008)

Issue: The level of specificity that should be provided by certain Union officials when reporting their official time.

2. National Labor Relations Board, Office of General Counsel, Washington, DC and National Labor Relations Board Union, Case No. 07 FSIP 90 (January 16, 2008)

Issues: Appropriate arrangements and procedures arising from management's decision to display the American flag at representation elections, including whether: (1) the Employer should purchase flags of differing weights and heights and, if so, Board agents should have the discretion to select which flag to display; (2) Board agents traveling via common carrier should be authorized to incur reasonably necessary excess baggage charges to transport the flag and accompanying luggage; and (3) the parties' Advisory Committee on Health and Safety (ACES) and the Designated Agency Safety and Health Official (DASHO) should be involved in establishing weight and bulk standards for materials Board agents transport to elections prior to the implementation of the requirement to display the flag.
